God has been so good to us as we have been constructing our church building. **Many churches have generously given and God has provided exactly at the time we needed it.** We have reached to the level of the roof and God has already provided the money for the roof, thanks to a very generous gift from a church in Texas. We also have the money to put in the windows and doors thanks to a generous gift from a church in Canada.

Discipleship

It is a blessing to not only see the physical building of our church but the spiritual building as well. Right now, **we have 10 people being disciplined by the church members** with others soon following.

Bible College

We had a good TBI (tri-annual Bible institute) in Mbarara **with over 50 men from southwestern Uganda attending.** We took 6 men from Kasese. The courses that were taught were the books of Philippians and Colossians along with some much needed Christian Home helps. I taught along with 5 of our Ugandan men who did a great job. While the students were encouraged by the teaching, I was encouraged by the teachers.

In the Bible college in Kasese we started our next term with 5 students. The courses this term are Bibliology and the book of Romans.

We also started the next term in Bwera with 6 students. The two courses this term are the Charismatic Movement and the book of Acts.

Missions Trip to Rwanda

I had the privilege to take a missions trip to Rwanda. Rwanda is a country that is on the southern border with Uganda. It was a 7-hour bus ride to reach the capital of Rwanda where I was met by former Ugandan missionaries Jeff and Carla Bassett and a Rwandan preacher, Bro. Sadock.

The purpose of this trip was to begin the process of getting a Bible institute started to train men there in Rwanda who want to serve the Lord in the ministry. We can use the same pattern for what we do here in Uganda. We were able to work out many details and **I look forward to working closely with Bro. Sadock in the future to assist in the training of Rwandan men to reach their fellow countrymen for Christ.**

While I was in Rwanda I was impressed with the great and effectual door that is open to preach the Gospel and train preachers and pastors. Perhaps God would speak to your heart about being a missionary to Rwanda. **Pray the Lord of the harvest would send more laborers into the harvest field of Rwanda!**
