First Boda Riders Conference

We had our first ever Boda Riders Conference. A boda is a type of public transportation around town. It is a man on a motorcycle who will take you (and up to three others at the same time) just about anywhere you want to go. He will even carry all kinds of cargo.

Most boda riders are young men who are looked down upon by the society as lazy, common, and useless. Most people do not care anything about these men, but we wanted to show them that we do care and Jesus cares for them.

We hosted a conference and invited boda riders to come. There were 152 that accepted our invitation. We played some motorcycle related games, had the traffic police come and talk about road safety, we preached to them and fed them lunch. We then gave all of them New Testaments, booklets about salvation, and a reflector vest.

I had the opportunity to travel to 2 towns in the Busoga region of Uganda and teach in 2 TBI's with my brother, Keith. We met with over 50 Baptist pastors, who had not been well-trained, to begin teaching them the Word of God. For this TBI, we taught them 11 basic Bible doctrines. Now they will be able to go back to their villages and teach their people what they learned.

Please pray for these pastors as they are desperate to learn the Word of God so they can teach their people. They were not well prepared, but they are doing what they can.
