We are excited to be involved in the new church plant in Karusandara. After going out there every Tuesday for a Bible study, we believed it was time to begin Sunday services.

As Karusandara is a bit of a distance from Kasese town, it would be difficult for them to pay for transport to come to church every Sunday. Therefore, we believed it was the Lord's timing to begin holding Sunday services out there, with the goal of organizing the baptized believers into a church.

I appreciate all the men from the town church who have been willing to come out every week to teach the Bible study lessons, teach the children's classes, do soulwinning, and discipleship. What a difference they have made!

Lastly, they preached a 10-15 minute message on Sunday morning in the main service.
