We sent nine teenagers and one counsellor five hours away to Kisojjo Independent Baptist Camp, which is run by a missionary friend. The theme was "Being about my Father's Business." They had a great time and came back challenged to be about their Father's business. They all gave testimonies on the Sunday after their return, and the church was definitely challenged and encouraged. We are thankful for this ministry that our missionary friend provides for our teenagers.

Bible College

We started the new year again with Rwenzori Baptist College. We have fifteen students (including Marcus now) and the courses are Cults and 1 & 2 Peter. The Lord willing we will have four that will graduate this year.

Mountain Ministry

We praise the Lord that we were finally able to get the Rwenzori Mountain Ministry started. It is a week-long trip up into the mountains where we go soul winning and preach in the trading centers where most people don't want to go.

I took three of our men with me - Zebedee, Expedito and Alfred. During the week we went to five different trading centers -Kithoma, Ribweryakyona, Kalibwa, Kiraro, and Kararo. We had open air preaching in all five trading centers, and we also preached in 3 different schools to a combined 340 students. We passed out many Lhukonzo tracts and answered a lot of questions about who we are. They have never seen such a group of people before. Many responses were like this: "This must be the truth if these people care to come up here and give us the Gospel." "I've never heard such a Gospel before, but I can tell it is the truth." "If this is a real Baptist church, then we need one here." "I have not been to a church in over a year. Please come and start a church in our trading center."

We had twenty-two people make a profession of faith in Christ during the week. Amen! We plan to go back next month and do some follow-up and discipleship. Please pray that God will use these who got saved to help plant churches in these villages.

Lhukonzo Translation

The team has finished translating the John and Romans into Lhukonzo. Now we are going back to check it. We have finished checking John and are working on Romans. I can't wait to be able to pass out a Lhukonzo John and Romans!
