Baptism in the Mountains

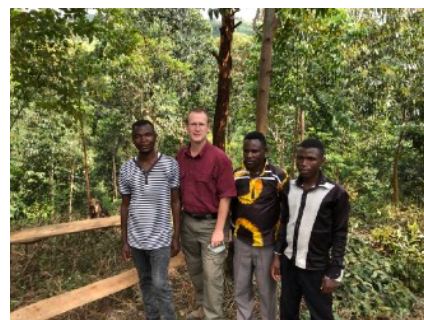
We started the mountain ministry back in February visiting several trading centers and preaching the Gospel to them. We had many professions of faith at that time. We knew that because of the “white skin” some would say or do anything. Our plan was to send two Ugandan men back up into the mountains in the following months to see who was serious and start discipling them.

The lockdown really hampered our efforts, but our guys kept going up as often as they could. As the months passed we realized that there was only one trading center that had people who were serious about their salvation. That trading center is called Ribweryakona (Ree-bwe-rya-chona).

As the lockdown restrictions were eased a bit, the men started going every week for discipleship. They began to have a core of believers who really wanted to know the truth and were willing to apply it. We scheduled a baptism service in November. Many had planned to be baptized, but because of the pressure from relatives, only three accepted to obey the Lord in believer's baptism. We were encouraged by the response from the village in what we were preaching. Others have taken courage from these three, and we are already planning a second baptism. Please pray for this new preaching point that God will give us wisdom in planting another Bible believing Baptist church.
