We finished the last term of Bible college for 2021. The courses were Sign Language Interpreters Training and the book of Revelation. Many of the students "feared" the book, but at the end said they now really enjoy the book of Revelation. He invited them to the church and for two days he had games for them, fed them, and then had many sessions of preaching. There were over 100 that were in attendance. Many of them wanted to know more about the church that "cares for the elderly." What a testimony that was! It was a great blessing!

We have been truly thankful for the peace that God has given to us these many years here in Uganda. While many countries surrounding us have have rebels, wars, and devestating struggles, we have been relatively safe and peaceful here. On November 16, I was on my way to a dentist appointment for Kendra in the capital (seven hours away from our home), when my wife called and said there had been some bombs that were detonated in Kampala and we needed to get to the dentist right away. They wanted everyone to go home, but the dentist was willing to wait for us. Other than a lot of traffic congestion because of this, we were safe and were never in any danger. What a blessing!
