We are Now Free to Move About the Country

We praise the Lord that at the beginning of the year, President Museveni opened up much of the country with a promise to fully open everything else once schools had been open for two weeks. That was January 24, and he did keep his word. We are now open and back to where we were, ministry-wise, before the pandemic.

Bible college started up again with 37 students in four locations of the district. Praise the Lord, the graduates from last year are now assisting me in teaching at three of these locations. This first term is Bible Doctrines 1 and OT Chronological Part 1.

We also had our first TBI (tri-annual Bible institute) with over 40 in attendance for the week-long course. We taught the basic fundamentals of personal evangelism and then had them practice on each other. We also gave them different ways to witness to different people and especially those of other religions.

The police have allowed us to start meeting with them at their Monday morning assembly again. I am thankful for the opportunity to preach to them and pray with them. They also recently allowed us to go back into the jails and preach to the suspects. God has opened up the Mubuku Prison to us as well. We had the opportunity to preach to over 400 prisoners at a time. What a blessing it was to see the prisoners excited that we were there for them.

In February, we had our first Heavenly Marriage Seminar with 22 couples attending. My dad spoke for that conference and my mom also taught a split-session for ladies. We had a lot of fun with many games, good food and really good Bible teaching on the home.
